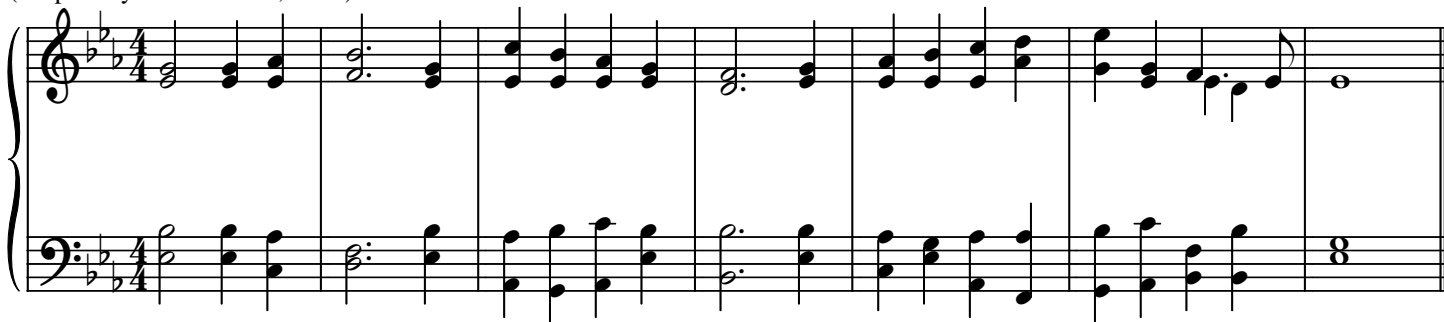


Draw nigh and take the Body of the Lord
